This landmark building is located on the SE corner of Lowry Avenue and 4th Avenue NE in an emerging neighborhood. Known for the frolicking pink goat painted on the Lowry side, it is also one of the chosen few buildings that is home to an original Mows510 house. Both works of art have made this building a destination for photo opps and Mows510 house seekers. The property has two recently renovated upper level apartments and retail space on the first floor currently leased to Sacred Siren Tattoo & Art.
